"A high level document guiding service planning in our North Zone - Noting gaps and moving to act!"



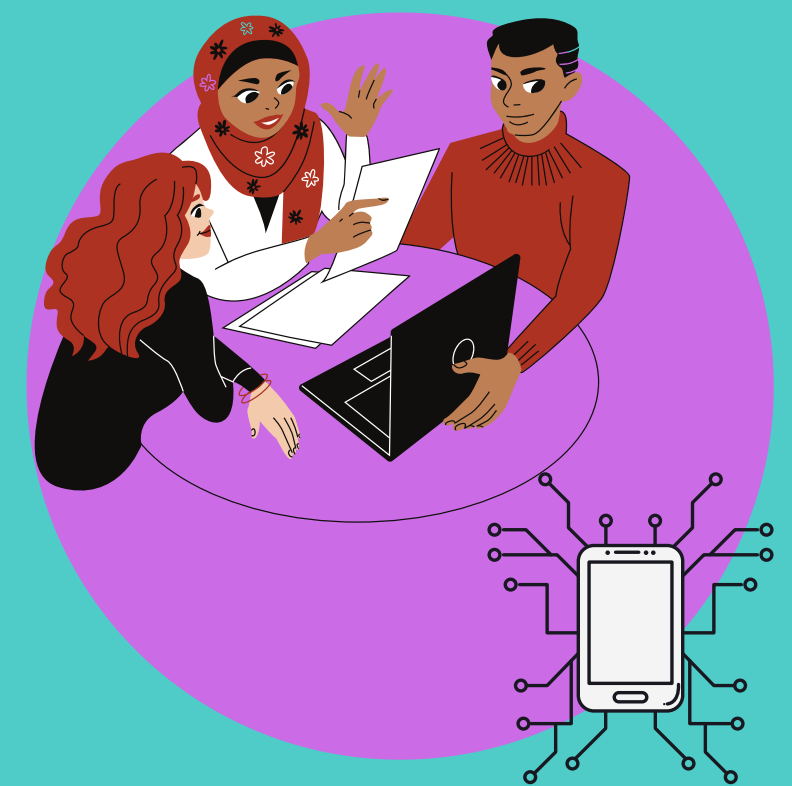
GOALS:
